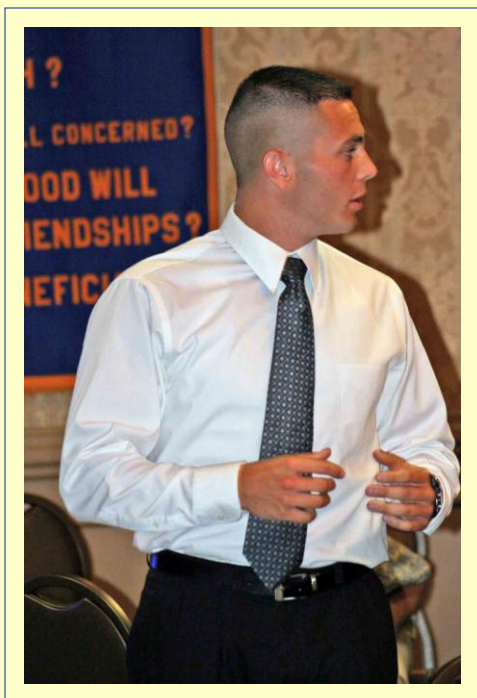
### This Week's Speaker:
